COMPARISONS 2

1.- "AS + ADJ + AS" = "Tan + ADJ + como"

In order to say: "tan grande como", "tan joven como", "tan triste como",

" tan inteligente como", etc, we use the following structure:

AS + adj + AS

My dog is as fast as yours.

Mary is **as tall as** Paul.

You are as intelligent as her.



Remember that:

- we do not have to add any suffix to the ADJECTIVE we cannot say: "as faster as", "as taller as", or "as more intelligent as"
- the <u>number of **syllables**</u> of the adjective is **not important.** We just have to write:

AS

<u>FAST</u>
<u>Tall</u>
INTELLIGENT

AS

2.- "LESS+ ADJ + than" = "MENOS + ADJ + que"

In order to say: "menos interesante que", "menos atractiva que", "menos feliz que", "menos inteligente que", etc, we use the following structure:

LESS+ adj+ than

A film is **less** interesting than a book.

Cats are **less** intelligent than dogs.



Remember that:

- we do **not** have to add any suffix to the **ADJECTIVE**we **cannot** say: "Less happier than", "less more interesting than" "less taller than"
- the <u>number of syllables</u> of the adjective is **not important.** We just have to write:



3.- "The LEAST+ ADJ" = "El MENOS + ADJ"

In order to say: "el menos interesante", "la menos atractiva", "el menos feliz", "el menos inteligente", etc, we use the following structure:

The LEAST+ adj than

Esta película es <u>la menos</u>interesante = This film is the least interesting.

Los gatos son <u>los menos</u>inteligentes = Cats are <u>the least</u> intelligent.



Remember that:

 we do not have to add any suffix to the ADJECTIVE we cannot say: "The least happier", "The least more interesting"

"The least taller"

• the <u>number of **syllables**</u> of the adjective is **not important.**We just have to write:



HAPPY
Interesting
INTELLIGENT
